Date:	January 29-30, 2022 This meet is subject to change or cancellation depending on weather, ice conditions and COVID-19 restrictions.
Location:	Brewer Skate Park, 100 Brewer Way, Ottawa ON
Format:	The Championships include only Olympic Style racing due to COVID restrictions. See the 2021-2022 OSSA Long Track Technical Bulletin for details.
Skater Eligibility:	Skaters with an OSSA competitive membership who are aged 9 years old and above as of July 1, 2021 are eligible for the Ontario Provincial Long Track Championships. Out-of-Province skaters aged 9 years old and above are eligible to participate if space allows and if all COVID regulations can be followed. Out-of-Province skaters are not eligible for Provincial medals.
COVID Regulations:	All affected persons, as specified in the Ontario Speed Skating Vaccination Policy , are required to be Fully Vaccinated for this event. Proof of vaccination is required. Physical distancing, masking and sanitization requirements will be in place.
Sanctioned By:	The Ontario Speed Skating Association and Speed Skating Canada
Entry Fee:	\$20.00 +HST (\$22.60) per distance. \$90.40 for all 4 distances. Payment made to OSSA via e-transfer to executivedirector@ontariospeedskating.ca using the password OSSA2022. E-transfers will only be accepted by OSSA once we can confirm that the competition will proceed. Contact OSSA if you require a different method of payment. Payment due Monday January 24 at 11:59pm.
Entry Deadline:	Monday January 24 at 11:59pm. Refunds for individual requests will not be issued after the Entry Deadline. No exceptions including medical circumstances. If the competition is cancelled due to weather or COVID-19, refunds will be issued.
