Location:	Hespeler Memorial Arena, 640 Ellis Road, Cambridge, ON – Rink #2
Skater Eligibility:	Skaters ages 6 - 10 and 11 – 13 (NEW SKATERS ONLY) This will be a mix gender format. A maximum of 70 skaters will be accepted on a first come first serve basis with priority given to western region skaters.
Sanctioned By:	Speed Skating Ontario
Seed times:	Skaters are asked to submit the following times: Ages 6-10: 200m time/100m track Ages 11-13: 400m time/100m track. Practice 'seed' times are acceptable.
Warm Ups:	No on ice warm-ups are planned. Dryland warmups can be done in or outside of the arena.
Entry Fee:	\$25.00 per person. No refunds for any reason, unless CSSC cancels the event.
Entry Deadline:	Maximum of 70 registrations must be received by Tuesday, October 25 th , by 6:00 pm

Meet Description	This is a ladder meet. The initial ladder (i.e. skater groupings) will be built using the time provided at registration. Skaters will then move up and down the ladder (i.e. skater group) based on finishing positions. The ladder movement is based purely on position; i.e. first place skater moves up a group, last place skater moves down a group. Skaters who are penalized during a race will move down two (2) groups. We anticipate having two (2) ladders. One for the 11 - 13 age skaters will be a 400m race and a second one for 6 - 10 age skaters will be a 200m race. We hope to be able to record times for the skaters as well. This depends on having enough volunteers (i.e. volunteers to be timers). Awards, if any, are to be determined.
