| Skater Eligibility: | <p>All skaters must have a Speed Skating Ontario Club Membership to be eligible to participate in the Ontario Regional Celebration.</p> <p>The Ontario Regional Celebration is for skaters aged 4-8 years old before July 1, 2025. Other novice skaters who did not participate in the Ontario Provincial Championships or Ontario Elite Championships may register at the discretion of their Club Coach. In general, it is recommended that skaters are in stages 5-8 of the Speed Skating Canada First and Fast Strides program, if the program is used at their Club.</p> <p>It is strongly recommended that skaters have raced in an Ontario Regional Meet in the 2025-2026 season to race in the Ontario Regional Celebration. If a skater has not participated in an Ontario Regional Meet in the 2025-2026 season, their participation is at the discretion of their Club Coach.</p> |

| Entry Fee: | \$65.00 per person. Refunds will only be issued in accordance with SSO's Refund Policy. |
| Entries Deadline: | <p>Register for the Celebration by Friday February 27, 2026 at 23:59.</p> <p>The early registration deadline for the Ontario Regional Celebration is Sunday February 15, 2026 at 23:59. To guarantee their t-shirt size, skaters must register by the early registration deadline. After this deadline we cannot guarantee sizes</p> <p>Late entries may be accepted, up to 24 hours after the close of registrations, if space allows. In addition to the registration fee a \$50.00 + HST late fee will apply. Late registration deadline is March 1 at 12noon</p> |
