Date:	Sunday October 22, 2023
Location:	River Oaks Community Centre 2400 Sixth Line Oakville, ON The River Oaks Community Centre is located on the territory of the Haudenosaunee Anishinabewaki, Attiwonderonk (Neutral), Mississauga and Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation peoples.
Format:	Skaters aged 13-29 will race in mixed gender groups with seeding based on ability. See the 2023 -2024 Technical Bulletin for details.
Skater Eligibility:	Skaters aged 13-29 with a Speed Skating Ontario Competitive Membership. Entry Time Standards for SSO Time Trials (skated since August 1, 2022) 500m: M: 1:05.00; F: 1:10.00 or 400m: M: 0:53.06 F: 0:57.14
Out Province Skaters	An out-of-province skater is registered as a speed skater in another Province, Territory or State other than Ontario. Out-of-province skaters may be considered to attend the Ontario Time Trials provided they register as per the posted timelines; they meet the age requirement and time standards and there are no remaining waitlisted skaters from in-province. Acceptance into the meet will be dependent upon space availability in the meet, and will be determined by the Chief Referee, Chief Recorder and Technical Director.

Sanctioned By:	Speed Skating Ontario and Speed Skating Canada
Entry Fee:	\$84.75 (\$75.00 + HST) per person. No refunds after the close of all entries.
Entry Deadline:	Wednesday October 11, 2023 at 11:59pm. There is no extended deadline.

Check In:	Coaches are required to check in and confirm skater participation.
