Location:	Allandale Recreation Centre, 190 Bayview Dr, Barrie, ON L4N 4Y8 Speed Skating Ontario and the Barrie Speed Skating Club acknowledge that the ice we skate on and the lands we gather upon are the traditional territories of the Anishinabewaki くっいうしゃくり, Wendake-Nionwentsïo, Ho-de-no-sau-nee-ga (Haudenosaunee), and Mississauga peoples. Skater Eligibility:	Skaters aged 13-29 with a Speed Skating Ontario Competitive membership who meet the Elite time standard on the SSO Ranking List since August 1, 2024 are eligible for the Ontario Single Distance Event in Barrie: 500m: M: 1:00.00; F: 1:05.00 400m: M: 0:48.98; F: 0:53.06 Ontario athletes currently training at Regional Training Centres and retired skaters from the Canadian Senior national racing pathway who met the Elite time standard before their retirement can join the Ontario Single Distance Events. These skaters must have a current Speed Skating Ontario Competitive or National membership.

Entry Fee:	\$80.00 + HST per person.
Entry Deadline:	Wednesday August 27, 2025 at 11:59pm.  Late entries may be accepted, up to 24 hours after the close of registrations, if space allows. In addition to the registration fee a \$50 + HST late fee will apply.
Entries via:	All skaters must register through IceReg.
Scratches:	Coaches are required to notify the Provincial Registrar as soon as they become aware of a scratch.
Volunteers:	If you are interested in volunteering, please let us know through the registration process in IceReg.

Coaches:	Coaches in the coaches' box must meet the SSO requirements indicated in the SSO Technical Bulletin.  Coaches are required to register in advance of the meet in IceReg.
Coaches and Officials Meeting:	The Coaches and Officials meeting time/location will be shared within 24 hours of the meet.
Warm Ups:	Warmup times will be confirmed with the final distribution.
