Skater Eligibility:	Skaters 5 years old and up, with a Speed Skating Ontario membership. Priority is given to these clubs, who participated in the last event: Brampton, Cambridge, Hamilton, Golden Horseshoe, KW, London, Meteor, Milton, Oakville, Quinte, Toronto, and Buffalo. Participants from other clubs accepted at the organizer's discretion.
