Format:	Ability seeding. Mixed gender racing. All points format. Relays may be included if time allows. Relay priority is for skaters preparing to represent Ontario at Canadian Youth Short Track Championships. See the 2026-2027 SSO Technical Bulletin for details.
Skater Eligibility:	Skaters aged 9-12 as of July 1, 2026 with a recommended 400m time standard of 1:08.00 Skaters aged 13-29 as of July 1, 2026, who do not meet time standards for the Elite Circuit, or who decline racing in the Elite Circuit. Special O Skaters All skaters are required to have a Speed Skating Ontario Competitive membership. Sanctioned By:	Speed Skating Ontario (SSO)
Entry Fees and Deadline:	Early Registration Deadline: Register before October 18, 2026 \$80.00 Registration Deadline: October 28, 2026 \$90.00 (Fees after the Early Registration Deadline and before the Registration Deadline on October 28, 2026) Late entries may be accepted, up to 24 hours after the close of registrations, if space allows. In addition to the registration fee a \$50.00 late fee will apply.
Entries via:	Eligible skaters from Ottawa, Gloucester, St. Lawrence, Kingston, Quinte, Kawartha, Durham, Markham, Toronto, Meteor, York and Flex Clubs must register through IceReg. The registration link can be found on the SSO website. Skaters looking to register as an Out-of-Region or Out-of-Province skater must register on the Wait List in IceReg. After the Entry Deadline, SSO will review meet capacity and determine if there is space available in the meet for Out of Region skaters. Out of Region skaters accepted into the meet will be provided with a passcode to complete their registration. Only skaters on the waitlist will be accepted into the meet. Check In:	Coaches are required to notify the Provincial Registrar as soon as they become aware of a scratch.
Volunteers:	If you are interested in volunteering, please let us know through the registration process in IceReg.
Coaches:	Coaches in the coaches' box must meet the SSO requirements indicated in the SSO Technical Bulletin. Coaches are required to register in advance of the meet in IceReg.
Coaches and Officials Meeting:	The Coaches and Officials meeting time/location will be shared within 24 hours of the meet.
Warm Ups:	Warmup times will be confirmed with the final distribution.
