Skater Eligibility:	All skaters must have a Speed Skating Ontario Club Membership to be eligible to participate in the Ontario Regional Celebration.
	The Ontario Regional Celebration is for skaters aged 4-8 years old before July 1, 2024. Other novice skaters who did not participate in the Ontario Provincial Championships or Ontario Elite Championships may register at the discretion of their Club Coach. In general, it is recommended that skaters are in stages 5-8 of the Speed Skating Canada First and Fast Strides program, if the program is used at their Club.
	It is strongly recommended that skaters have raced in an Ontario Regional Meet in the 2024-2025 season to race in the Ontario Regional Celebration. If a skater has not participated in an Ontario Regional Meet in the 2024-2025 season, their participation is at the discretion of their Club Coach.

Entry Fee:	60\$ per person. No refunds after the close of registration.
Entry Deadline:	The early registration deadline for the Ontario Regional Celebration is Sunday February 23, 2025. To guarantee your t-shirt size, register by the early registration date. Registrations will be accepted until the final registration deadline of Sunday March 2, 2025. Late registrations will not be accepted.
Entries via:	All skaters must register through IceReg
Volunteers:	Please let us know if you are interested in volunteering when completing registration through IceReg.
Coaches:	Coaches in the coaches' box must meet the NCCP and SSO requirements indicated in SSO in the Technical Bulletin. Coaches are required to register in advance of the meet on the "Meet Information" page on the SSO website. The Coaches Meeting time/location will be shared within 24 hours before the meet.
Officials:	The Officials meeting time/location will be shared within 24 hours before the meet.
Warm Ups:	Warmup times will be confirmed with the final distribution.
